Vaccination Schedule

Puppies/Dogs

8-9 weeks	DA2PP #1	Distemper, Adenovirus, Parainfluenza, Parvovirus & Bordetella #1 (if your pet will be going to a groomer, dog park or boarding kennel)
11-12 weeks	DA2PP #2	Distemper, Adenovirus, Parainfluenza, Parvovirus & Bordetella #2 (if your pet will be going to a groomer, dog park or boarding kennel)
15-16 weeks	DA2PP #3	Distemper, Adenovirus, Parainfluenza, Parvovirus & Rabies

Street Paws, Inc. recommends a follow up examination and the appropriate vaccinations in one year. We also strongly recommend spaying or neutering your puppy by six months of age.

****Note-** your Veterinarian may recommend additional vaccines or a modified vaccination schedule based on your pets needs.

1 Year		DA2PP, Rabies and Bordetella (every 6 months)
2-4 Years		DA2PP (at 2 years of age); Parvo (at 3 years of age); Rabies (annually); Bordetella (every 6 months)
5-7 Years		DA2PP (at 5 years of age); Parvo (at 6 years of age); Rabies (annually); Bordetella (every 6 months)
8 Years and Older-typically the Seniors		DA2PP (at 8 & 11 years of age); Parvo (at 9 & 12 years of age); Rabies (annually); Bordetella (every 6 months)

Vaccination Schedule

****Note:** After 13 years of age some vaccinations may not be considered appropriate for your dog. Your Veterinarian may recommend additional vaccines or a modified vaccination schedule based on your pets needs.

Kittens/Cats

8-9 weeks	Feline Leukemia Virus (FeLV) and Feline Immunodeficiency Virus (FIV) test	FVRCP #1 (Panleukopenia (Distemper); Rhinotracheitis (Herpes); Calcivirus) and FeLV #1
11-12 weeks		FVRCP #2 (Panleukopenia (Distemper); Rhinotracheitis (Herpes); Calcivirus) and FeLV #2
15-16 weeks		FVRCP #3 (Panleukopenia (Distemper); Rhinotracheitis (Herpes); Calcivirus) and

****Note-** your Veterinarian may recommend additional vaccines or a modified vaccination schedule based on your pets needs.

1 Year		FVRCP; FeLV, and Rabies
2-4 Years		2 yrs- Rhinotracheitis/Calci; FeLV and Rabies 3 yrs- Panleukopenia (FPV); FeLV and Rabies 4 yrs- FeLV and Rabies

5-7 Years		5 yrs- Rhinotracheitis/Calci; FeLV and Rabies 6 yrs- Panleukopenia (FPV); FeLV and Rabies 7 yrs- FeLV and Rabies
8 Years and Older-typically the Seniors		8 & 11 yrs- Rhinotracheitis/ Calci; FeLV and Rabies 9 & 12 yrs- Panleukopenia (FPV); FeLV and Rabies 10 & 13 yrs- FeLV and Rabies

Note: After 13 years of age some vaccinations may not be considered appropriate for your cat. Your Veterinarian may recommend additional vaccines or a modified vaccination schedule based on your pets needs.
